Exterior Films Excellence

(part 3 in a 3 part series)



Parts 1 and 2 of this 3 part series covered the reasons why exterior films are growing in applications, plus the issues around film longevity in service.

Hanita Coatings manufactures two product lines of exterior films: SolarZone and XtraZone films. The XtraZone line is new – introduced in 2008, and uses new “second-generation” technology that results in longer film lifetimes.

One of the most exciting exterior films on the market is the XtraZone Titan™ product line – available in VLT’s of 20, 35 and 50%. This product has a neutral appearance, an extremely durable scratch-resistant coating, and Total Solar Energy Rejection of 53% to 74% depending on the VLT. Titan is quickly becoming an extremely popular film in the US.

The differences in product lines can be seen in the tables below:

None of these films carry a film warranty when applied to sloped or horizontal glass without edges being sealed. Further, these films all carry a full \$500 glass breakage / thermal shock warranty on any windows they are applied to, including Low E, triple pane, and laminated glass.
